

Winter Kindergarten Connection Activities



- Practice reading the Letter People books that you have at home. Identify the characters, setting, and plot of each story.
- Write a new story for one of the Letter People.
- Find objects around your house that start with each letter of the alphabet.
- Find 2-D and 3-D shapes at home. We have learned circle, square, triangle, rectangle, hexagon, cone, sphere, cylinder, cube, and rectangular block.
- Write color words on pieces of paper. Choose one color each day and look for that color for the whole day.
- Practice writing the letters we have learned so far as both capital letters and lower-case letters: Mm, Tt, Ff, Nn, Hh, Aa, Pp, Zz, Bb, Ii, Ss, Dd. Create a list of words that start with each letter. Add to it as you think of new words.
- Go on a Christmas hunt and look for signs of Christmas (trees, angels, Mary, Joseph, Baby Jesus, lights, stars, presents). Count how many of each object you can find.
- Count how many presents are under the Christmas tree.
- Write thank you notes for Christmas gifts.
- Create a matching memory game with scraps of different colors of wrapping paper glued to index cards.
- Read the Christmas story from Luke 2:1-20.
- Sing Christmas carols together with friends or family. Highlight sight words that your student is learning to follow along and read those words.
